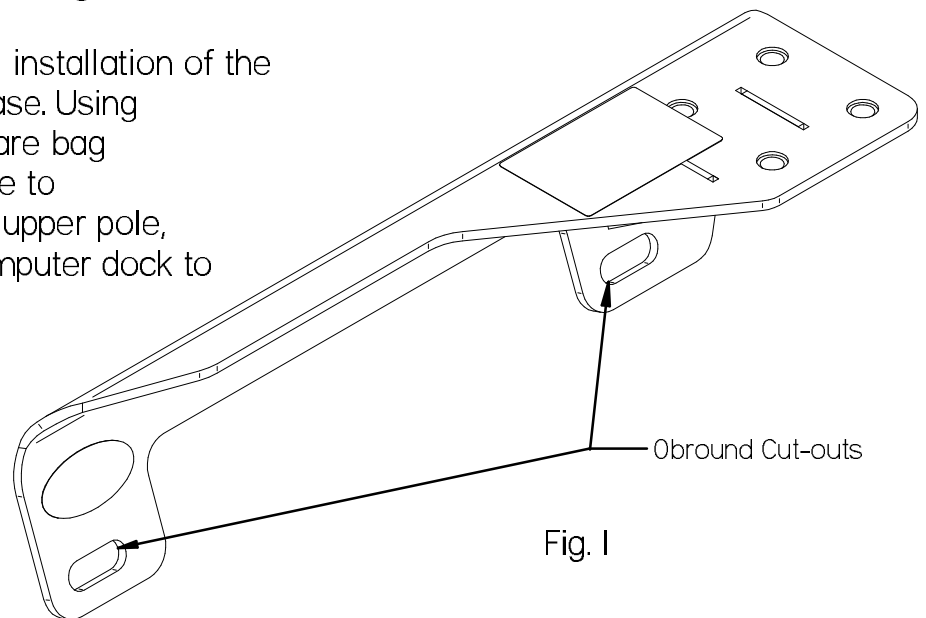
- You must read and follow all of these installation instructions. Failure to follow the installation instructions may result in serious bodily injury or death.

1. Begin the installation of the vehicle base removing the front seat bolts of the front passenger's seat in the Colorado, or Canyon.

2. Align the base so that the two obround cut-outs are over the seat bolt holes

3. Re-insert the seat bolts and tighten.

4. This completes the initial installation of the Colorado/Canyon Vehicle base. Using hardware supplied in hardware bag 7120-0039 attach lower pole to Colorado/Canyon base. Add upper pole, motion attachment, and computer dock to complete the install.

It will be necessary to puncture the label to access the attached nut.

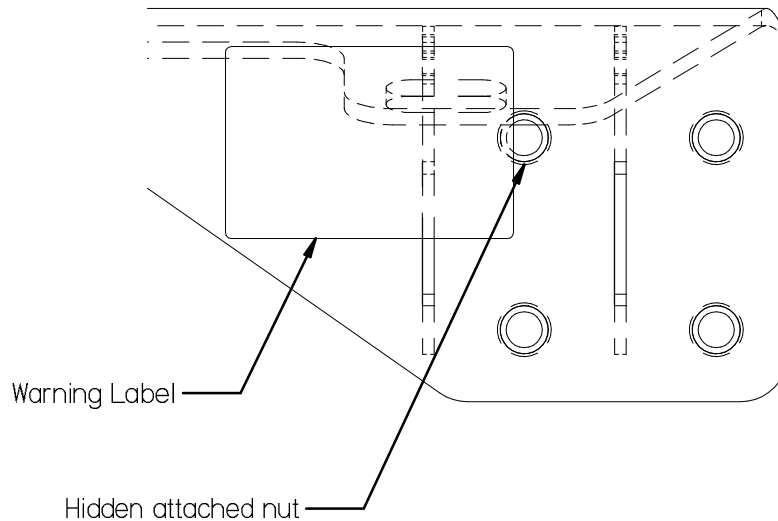
