

The purpose of this installation instruction sheet is to illustrate the manufacturer's recommended method of installation of the Ford Crown Victoria Leg Kit. The new leg kit can be used in combination with the Ford Crown Victoria Vehicle Base (7160–0234) for installations where more peripheral mounting space is desired.

- I. Begin by removing the in-board, forward most seat bolts of both the passenger's and driver's side seats.
- 2. Loosen the out-board, forward most seat bolts of the same seats.
- 3. Slide the two anchor legs between the seat frame and the vehicle floor oriented as shown in Fig. I. Either mounting hole on the anchor legs can be used. Determine the best arrangement based on weight and placement of the components to be added after the leg kit and top plate are installed. Replace and tighten the fasteners removed in Step I.
- **4**. The rear leg can be installed at any time now. It is recommended that the rear leg is fastened to the top plate using the I/4-20 flat head screw included in the hardware bag prior to fastening the top plate to the anchor legs. Orient the rear leg as shown in **Fig. I** with the vertical flange facing towards the rear of the vehicle.
- 5. Fasten the top plate to the anchor legs as in Fig. 2.
- 6. Adjust the tension on the plate by loosening the nuts on the vertical flange of the rear leg (see Fig. 3). Pry the top plate up and tighten the nuts. This completes the installation of the Ford Crown Victoria Leg Kit. Add a console, cup holder, arm rest, and other components to complete the solution.
