

The purpose of this instruction sheet is to illustrate the manufacturer's recommended method of installing the Ford Fusion 2013+ vehicle base. The base requires no drilling.



Installation

- 1. Remove the seat bolts located at the front of the passenger seat.
- 2. Loosen but do not remove the seat bolts at the back of the passenger seat.
- 3. Orient the base with the bent flange towards the front of the vehicle.
- 4. Slide the base between the seat legs and the vehicle floor pan (see Figure 2).
- 5. Align the slots of the base with the mounting holes on the seat and vehicle floor.
- 6. Re-insert the bolts that were removed in STEP 1.
- 7. Tighten all four (4) seat bolts securing the passenger seat.
- 8. Secure the Offset Riser to the base.
