

The DS-122 is a No Holes Bored base that mounts between the upper portion of the passenger seat track and seat cushion.

Installation of the DS-122: See Figure I.

- 1. Remove the (2) front 5/16" hex nuts that hold the passenger seat cushion to the seat track brackets.
- 2. Lifting on the front of the seat cushion, separate the front of the seat from the seat track brackets.
- 3. Position the DS-122 on top of the seat track brackets so the slots in the DS-122 line up with the holes in the seat track brackets.
- 4. Lower the seat cushion back into place, allowing the studs to pass through the holes in the DS-122 and seat track brackets.
- 5. Re-attach the (2) 5/16" hex nuts that you removed in step 1.

Installation of Optional Gusset: See Figure 2.

The optional Silverado Gusset is a brace used to stabalize the mount, and to lock the seat in place.

- I. Move the passenger seat back to the rear most position.
- 2. Remove the transmission side seat nut that attaches the passenger seat to the floor.
- 3. Place the gusset over the floor stud and replace the nut. Do not tighten at this time.
- 4. Attach the pole to the mount using the 3/8" hardware that was provided with the pole. Replace two of the 3/8-16unc x 3/4" carrage bolts with the (2) 3/8-16unc x 1.00 long carrage bolts that were provided in hardware bag 7120-0237. Tighten the bolts in place.
- 5. Tighten the seat nut to the floor (from step 3).
