

**Logistics - Pivot Arm Mounts** 



This instruction sheet is for the Logistics - Pivot Arm Mounts. These mounts can be attached to any flat surface by drilling 9/32" diameter holes in the surface and bolting the pivot arm in place. The mounts comes with a back plate that has 1/4-20 threaded inserts that can be used when mounting to a plastic dash panel in a semi truck or other type of vehicle. The mounts come preassembed with either a round mounting plate containing the AMPs and NEC hole patterns or the Vesa 75mm mounting plate. Some models aslo come preassembled with a 50mm (2") long extension. Use the model that best fits your application with the mounting plate that matches the device being attached.





# Assembling the pivot mount:

- 1. Once the location has been determined in the vehicle, mark the mounting hole locations on the flat panel. Gamber-Johnson recommends verifying the marked locations with the back plate supplied with the mount since the holes will have to line up with the threaded fasteners.
- 2. Remove the dash panel (where the Pivot Arm Mount will be attached) if possible. If you cannot remove the dash panel, verify what is behind the dash before drilling. Drill 9/32" diameter holes at the marked locations.
- 3. Attach the Pivot Arm Mount to the panel with the back plate, 1/4" bolts, and lock washers supplied in the hardware bag. Reattach the dash panel to the vehicle dash if it was removed.
- 4. Attach the computer device being mounted with the hardware supplied with the device.
