

The 7160-1278 Yale/Hyster vehicle cab mount is designed to mount to the right front overhead guard leg on Yale GP040-070VX or Hyster H40-70FT series lift trucks with an enclosed cab. The mount attaches to the same locations as the windshield mounting brackets.

Attaching the mount:

- 1. The mount has multiple height level mounting options. The mount ships preassembled in the highest mounting location. If you want the mount lowered to a different location in the vehicle you will need to adjust the mount before installing it in the vehicle. See Figure 1.
- 2. To adjust the height, remove the 5/16" mounting bolts and adjust the adapter bracket to a secondary height location. Reattach in the new location with the 5/16" hardware.

- 3. Remove the (2) windshield bracket mounting bolts that attach the windshield mounting brakets to the right front overhead guard leg.
- 4. Place the 7160-1278 over the windshield mounting brackets and re-install the bolts to hold both the mount and the windshield brackets.
- 5. An optional material handling motion attachment (ie. 7160-0420 or 7160-0366) can now be added to the mount to hold the device being mounted. See Figure 3.
