

## **Weight Capacity**

Maximum flat panel weight:

360lbs.

THE CEILING STRUCTURE MUST BE CAPABLE OF HOLDING FIVE (5) TIMES THE WEIGHT OF THE FLAT PANEL AND MOUNT. IF NOT, THEN THE CEILING STRUCTURE MUST BE REINFORCED.

Do not install near sources of high heat. Do not install on a structure that is prone to vibration, movement or chance of impact.






The following tools may be required, dependent upon your particular installation. These tools are not provided by Premier Mounts, but you can purchase them at your local hardware store.






## Attaching the Dual Mounting Bracket to the 2" NPT Ceiling Adapter



The 2" NPT ceiling adapter (not included) must be firmly secured to the ceiling structure before performing the following steps.


- Align the dual mounting bracket with the threaded end of the 2" NPT ceiling adapter (not included).
- Thread the dual mounting bracket onto the 2" NPT ceiling adapter (not included) and rotate the dual mounting bracket clockwise at least four (4) complete revolutions.
- Use a screwdriver to tighten the Phillips set screw that is located on the 2" coupler.





Ensure that all connections are secure and tight before proceeding.

Proceed to the "Inserting the Hex Head Bolts" section.




## **Optional Ceiling Mount Accessories**


## **Inserting the Hex Head Bolts**

- Locate the two (2) upper mounting holes located on the back of the elliptical tilt mount.
- Attach two (2) M6 x 12mm hex head bolts and two (2) M6 split flat washers.
- Thread the hex bolts into the hole until there is a ½" gap between the head of the hex head bolt and the mounting surface of the elliptical tilt mount.
- Repeat steps 1 through 3 for the second elliptical tilt mount.



Do not completely tighten the hex head bolts at this time.

Proceed to "Attaching the Elliptical Tilt Mount to the Dual Mounting Bracket" section.



## Attaching the Elliptical Tilt Mount to the Dual Mounting Bracket




The following steps must be completed by two people.



Do not release the elliptical tilt mount until the hex head bolts are resting fully in the keyhole slots.

- Align the hex head with the keyhole slot.
- **2** Gently insert the hex head through the keyhole slot and lower the elliptical tilt mount.
- Align the lower mounting holes of the dual mounting bracket with the lower mounting points on the elliptical tilt mount.
- Thread two (2) M6 x 12mm hex head bolts two (2) M6 split flat washers into the mounting holes.
- Use a 10mm wrench and tighten all four (4) M6 x 12mm hex head bolts.
- Repeat steps 1 through 5 for mounting the second elliptical tilt mount.

Proceed to "Selecting the Mounting Hardware" section.





## **Selecting the Mounting Hardware**


- Insert the Thread Depth Indicator into the thread inserts found on the bottom or top of the flat panel.
- Use a pencil to mark the depth of the thread insert on the Thread Depth Indicator, as shown in Figure 1.
- Insert the Thread Depth Indicator into the remaining thread inserts to compare and verify their depth.
- Locate the correct diameter screw for the thread insert.

If the screw you selected is longer than the mark on the Thread Depth Indicator, as shown in Figure 2 and Figure 3, do not use this screw. The screw length must not bypass the mark.

**5** Test each size of the screws provided.

The correct screws should thread easily into the mount point and not pull out when tension is applied.

Proceed to the "Griplate™ Washer Installation" section.

## Griplate™ Washer Installation

Premier Mounts' Griplate™ Washers are designed to accommodate the various M4, M5, M6 and M8 hole sizes required by flat panels.



Do not place excessive pressure on the back of the flat panel, as this may damage your flat panel.



The Griplate™ Washer must be installed between the head of the mounting screw and the mounting bracket as shown.



Does your flat panel have:

- Recessed mount points?
- Uneven mount points?
- A curved back?
- Any obstruction near the mount point?

If Yes, you must install nylon spacers. Remove the mounting brackets, Griplate™ washers, and mounting screws from the back of the flat panel. Proceed to the "Nylon Spacer Installation" section.

If No, skip to the "Flat Panel Installation" section.

## **Nylon Spacer Installation**


Premier Mounts' nylon spacers allow you to attach the mounting bracket to flat panels which have recessed or uneven mount points. Each nylon spacer will add distance between the mounting bracket and your flat panel.



The nylon spacers must only be installed between the mounting bracket and your flat panel.

The nylon spacers will fit M4, M5, M6 and M8 screw sizes.

Proceed to the "Flat Panel Installation" section.





## **Flat Panel Installation**



Perform all structural reinforcements before attaching the flat panel to the ceiling mount.




Depending on your installation, it may be easier to route all cables prior to attaching the flat panel (see "Cable Management" section).



Do not release the flat panel until the mounting bracket arms are fully resting on the elliptical mounting bar.


- Raise the mounting bracket arms and the attached flat panel over the elliptical mounting bar of the ECM-3763D.
- 2 Lower and center the mounting bracket arms with the attached flat panel onto the elliptical mounting bar of the ECM-3763D.
- **3** Repeat steps 1 and 2 for mounting the second elliptical tilt mount.





Do not release the flat panel until the mounting bracket arms are resting fully on the elliptical mounting bar.

Proceed to "Attaching the Decorative Covers" section.





## **Attaching Decorative Covers**



When attaching the decorative covers, verify that the smaller mounting hole is above the larger mounting hole.


- Place the first decorative cover over the first mounting bracket arm and push firmly into place.
- Align the mounting holes together.
- Insert and tighten the M4 x 6mm Phillips screw (smaller mounting hole).
- Insert and tighten the M6 x 25mm Phillips screw (larger mounting hole).
- Repeat steps 1 through 4 for the second decorative cover and mounting bracket arm.





Do not over-tighten these screws.

Proceed to "Cable Management" section.




## Cable Management

Route the cables through the cable access holes and to their respective locations.

The cables must then be routed through the coupler, up the ceiling adapter (not included) and into the ceiling to a pre-determined power source.

Proceed to "Tilt Positioning" section.





## **Tilt Positioning**

#### **Adjusting the Flat Panel Friction Tilt Angle**


- 1.Place one hand at the center top edge of the flat panel.
- 2. Place the other hand on the center bottom edge of the flat panel.
- 3. Using the upper hand, gently pull the top of the flat panel toward you while the lower hand gently pushes the bottom of the flat panel away from you.




If additional tilt friction is required, tighten the lower nut and lower bolt only to increase the tilt friction.

#### Adjusting the Flat Panel to the Original Position

- 1. Place one hand at the center top edge of the flat panel.
- 2. Place the other hand on the center bottom edge of the flat panel.
- 3. Using the upper hand, gently push the top of the flat panel away from you while the lower hand gently pulls the bottom of the flat panel toward you.
